Clergy update— Licensing of Priest in Charge.

A new appointment can now be announced.

I am writing to inform you that the following announcement may be made in the parish churches of the Benefice of Etton and Dalton Holme on **Sunday 3 March, 2019**.

“The Reverend Richard Francis Parkinson, Rector of the Benefice of Cherry Burton, Assistant Curate of the Benefice of Etton with Dalton Holme, and Chaplain to Bishop Burton College, has been appointed Priest in Charge of the Benefice of Etton with Dalton Holme.

Mr Parkinson will be licensed by the Bishop of Hull on Thursday 21 March at 7.30pm in the Parish Church of St Mary, Etton.”
Rt Rev. Alison White, Bishop of Hull.

This appointment is part of the process of appointing a house for duty clergyman who will be responsible for conducting services at Etton and Dalton Holme (South Dalton) churches in addition to undertaking pastoral duties. This role will be performed by a semi-retired vicar who will work alongside the priest in charge.

The licensing service will be held at Etton church on Thursday 21st March at 7.30pm and everyone is invited to attend.
